**Some -er and -ir verbs with irregular yo forms**

- **Hacer** (to do, to make), **poner** (to put), **traer** (to bring), **saber** (to know), **ver** (to see), and **salir** (to go out) are regular -er/-ir verbs in the present tense except in the yo form. These are the irregular yo forms of the verbs.

**hago      pongo      traigo      sé      veo      salgo**

- **Salir + de** means to leave (a place). **Saber + de** means to know (about something).

Salgo del colegio a las tres.                      ¿Tú sabes mucho de ciencias?  
*I leave school at three o'clock.                      Do you know a lot about science?*
